Subject : Introduction of Pension Scheme in Delhi Transport Corporation w.e.f. 3rd August, 1981 as applicable to Central Government employees.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to DTC's letter No. Dy.CGM(Pen.)/93/73 dated 14th Sept. 1993 regarding DTC's Board's resolution for operation of pension scheme for DTC employees on the Central Government pattern by the DTC itself and to say that in partial modification of this Ministry's letter No. RT-12019/21/88-TAG dated 23rd November, 1992, the sanction of the Government is hereby accorded for operationalising the pension scheme by DTC itself subject to the following additional conditions :

- (a) The Government would not provide any budgetary support to DTC either now or in the future for the implementation of the pension scheme and if the pension fund is required to be augmented at any time in future, it would be done by increasing the employer's i.e. DTC's contribution and / or the employees contribution and the pension scheme itself will provide for these eventualities.
- (b) Approval of the Board of Directors will have to be taken by DTC at the earliest possible opportunity for suitably amending the Pension Fund Rules and disbursement of the pensionary benefits would carry the stipulation of such amendment to the Pension Fund Rules.

2. This issues with the approval of Finance Wing vide their U.C. No. 4096/FA(T)/95 dated 31.10.1995.
